iKare

The International Kappa Action Relief Effort, known simply as iKare was started to specifically help the victims of this Haiti tragedy and more importantly to establish a permanent program to financially assist future areas when affected by natural disasters.

Expanding number of scholarships for children (sometimes there are children who have supplies but lack resources for the fees and uniforms).

Substantially expanding the micro-credit lending fund from \$10,000 to enable more entrepreneurs, particularly women, to benefit from the fund and contribute to building viable economic infrastructure for.

Expansion of the Greenhouse Reforestation Jobs/Economic Program that HSP has funded. Local workers grow saplings that are sold to tourist who plant them in the National Park where the Citadel is located -- Excellent green, sustainable project.

Explore long term commitment to the Oasis Institute for Children orphaned by the earthquake.

Explore the creation of Haiti Investment Fund to enable the Local Development Committee to dramatically move forward on the vision of Milot being a Mecca for cultural-historical tourism (because of the Citadel) as the people-based engine for economic development for the area.

Explore joining with other major institutions to undertake humanitarian cruise/pilgrimage which we put on hold two years ago after the cholera outbreak.
